Microwave and Base Modification Instructions

Tools needed:

- Jack-nut reactor tool (e.g. Sealey AK 393)
- Stanley knife
- Phillips No2 screwdriver
- Flat bladed screwdriver or trim lever

Microwave and Base Modification Instructions

1. Remove the microwave's feet. A small flat blade screwdriver under the foot to lever it up is ideal.



2. Remove the rivet pin from the foot:



3. Carefully cut the barbs off flush with the top of each foot.





4. Screw Jack-nut onto the reactor tool and place into plain hole in base of Microwave, fully react and unscrew mandrill to release reactor tool.





5. Assemble plywood base to the microwave. Rebated holes to underside, plain side upwards. Add a washer under each screw and attach base through the feet, screwing into the Jack-nut.





6. Microwave and base can now be fitted into cupboard space with fascia.
